We will continue to send out newsletters and texts to communicate with you, but please do feel free to come in and tell us of ways to communicate so we can continue to work in partnership.



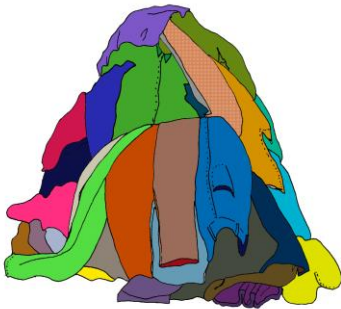

If you have a child starting Primary or Secondary school in September next year, the application process is now open and should be done on line. Closing date for Secondary places is 31st October 2017 and for Primary places 15th January 2018. If you do not have access to the internet, you are welcome to go along to the customer service centre in Broadgate House where staff can help you. We have leaflets available in the office for Reception starters, or just ask if you need any info.

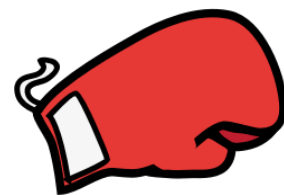
Lost Property
